From USA

Fly from San Fransisco, Los Angeles or Hawaii via Fiji

From New Zealand

Fly directly to Tonga from Auckland in less than three hours There is one flight a day weekly, excluding Tuesday and Sundays

From Australia

Fly directly to Tonga from Sydney

There are two flights a week from Sydney

From Mainland China

Flights daily from mainland China via Sydney or Auckland & three flights weekly from Hong Kong via Fiji

From Fiji

Fly directly to Tonga from Fiji

There are two flights from Suva and four from Nadi
