

Nandutí is not only a symbol of the creativity and skill of Paraguayan artisans but also a reflection of the country's cultural identity. This lace, considered Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity, has become an emblem of the rich textile tradition that remains alive in contemporary Paraguay. From delicate handkerchiefs to elegant dresses, Nandutí has crossed borders,
