The Republic OF Tajikistan is located in the southeastern part of Central Asia, with an area of 142,326 km². The Republic of Tajikistan borders Uzbekistan (1,322.9 km) to the northwest, Kyrgyzstan (987 km) to the northeast, China (494.95 km) to the east, and Afghanistan (1,344.15 km) to the south.

The population of the Republic of Tajikistan is more than 10 million people. The capital of the Republic of Tajikistan is the city of Dushanbe. 93% of Tajikistan's territory is mountainous, while only 7% is flat. Tajikistan has one of the highest peaks in the world (Ismoil Somoni Peak-7,495 m).

INFORMATION ABOUT THE WATER RESOURCES OF THE REPUBLIC OF TAJIKISTAN

Tajikistan is rich in water resources, has about 7,000 glaciers, 155 lakes of various sizes, tens of thousands of single malt and mineral springs and many reservoirs, and the number of rivers in Tajikistan reaches 947, each of which is more than 10 km long and 28,500 km in total. The Sir, Vakhsh, Zarafshan, Varzob, Kofarnihon and Panj rivers flow in Tajikistan.
